Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assistance (DEA) Program (Chapter 35)

• Spouses and children of Veterans who are permanently and totally disabled due to a servicerelated condition, or of Veterans who died while on active duty or as a result of a service-related condition

Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB/AD) Program (Chapter 30)

• Active Duty and Veterans who served on active duty for at least two years

Montgomery GI Selected Reserve (MGIB/SR) Program (Chapter 1606)

• Selected Reserve, including the Army Reserve, Navy Reserve, Air Force Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve and Coast Guard Reserve, and the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard

Reserve Educational Assistance (REAP) Program (Chapter 1607)

• Selected Reserve called to Active Duty in support of a contingency operation or a national emergency declared by the President or Congress

Veterans' Education Assistance Program (VEAP) Program (Chapter 32)

• Separated or Active Duty, if you elected to make contributions from your military pay

Vocational Rehabilitation Education Bene ts (VR&E) Program (Chapter 31)

- Veterans with a disability rating
- Counseling, training, education and job placement assistance
- Tuition, fees and books paid to school full amount

Tuition Assistance (TA)

- Active duty
- Air Force, Army, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard
- Tuition paid to school
- Tuition and fees up to \$4,500 per FY

Children of Fallen Patriots

- 40% of the tuition paid by JU
- 60% of the tuition paid by Children of Fallen Patriots foundation

ROTC

- Full scholarship
 - 4-year scholarship = full tuition, fees and stipend for full 4 years
 - 2 & 3-years scholarships = full tuition, fees and stipend for 2 or 3 years
